



LINKING FAO-WECAFC VISION & THE WTA REGION

- Fisheries production in the Wider Caribbean Region has declined by 40 percent over the last two decades. Fifty-five percent of commercially harvested fishery stocks are overexploited or depleted, and 40 percent of stocks are currently fully exploited. WECAFC is tagged to be among one of the world's most overexploited regions.
- "...fisheries is fully recognized for its contribution to fighting poverty, hunger and malnutrition, its ability to prepare for and respond to changing climate and ocean conditions, and its commitment to sustainability" (FAO, 2021).
- "Acknowledge that in order to scale up recent fisheries sustainability successes we need to implement and improve fisheries assessment and management systems in all regions, particularly in those where fish stock status is declining or unknown..." (FAO, 2021).

OPPORTUNITIES & SYNERGIES

- Regional partnerships to develop concerted approaches on both the resources and the health of marine environments, cross fertilization, and capacity building, economies of scale in effectively achieving the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development,
- Positions the WTA, WECAFC, and partners with the right access to data and information
- Harnessing the power of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) in supporting and tackling sustainability (IUU fishing, traceability, and data management)











OPERATIONALIZING OPPORTUNITIES FOR SYNERGIES

- The WECAFC Secretariat has taken an active role in the facilitation of regional partnerships to accomplish sustainable fisheries and ocean systems.
 - 1. The WECAFC Scientific Advisory Group: combining regional expertise of member States and partners including CRFM, CFMC, OSPESCA, CITES, IFREMER, NOAA-Fisheries
 - 2. The development and endorsed Strategic Action Plan for the CLME+ region, leveraging partnerships of more than 20 countries, UN agencies, and IGOs.
 - 3. Technical and scientific contributions to enable the Programme of Work
