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


What Do GRAs Expect From GOOS? GRF-IX Survey

<u>Three tiers</u> of GRA expectations related to GOOS, other GRAs and the GRA Forum (GRF-IX, Tokyo, Japan, 2019):

1. Expectation from GOOS Structure

- Some GRAs (60-65%) expect improved coordination, tighter connections and interactions between the GOOS structures (GOOS panels, OCG and JCOMMOPS)
- Improved feedbacks/interactions with Member States
- Expect support and advice from GOOS
- GOOS to better reflect the socio-economic aspects of GRA contributions






- 2. Expectations from other GRAS. Survey Event-based sampling-Heat Wave
- Opportunity to share best practices, knowledge, data & experiences, strengthen cooperation and coordination to enhance capacity for efficient use of resources and assets.
- Consolidate relationships between GRAs to enhance collaborative activities, observations and research projects.






SEAGOOS Ocean Acidification & Impact on Coral Reef Somkiat


3. Expectations from the GRA Forum:

Most of the GRAs (70-75%) have high expectations from the GRA Forum

- Opportunity to understand the status of different GRAs and discuss how GRAs can align in delivering according to GOOS principles / strategy
- Learn from other GRAs success, best practices and challenges
- The Forum helps to ensure effective coordination among GRAs, as well as in identifying common interest for project collaboration with other GRAs
- Strengthen collaboration with JCOMM (WMO IOC Joint Collaborative Board), IOC and WMO.

What Do GRAs Expect From GOOS? Opportunities

- Importance of harnessing national efforts "Harnessing the Power of National Capabilities and Multi-national Collaborations."
- Explore and map out existing capabilities, partners within the region that is not currently engaged with the GRA structures.
- Recognition by IOC of the GOOS Regional Council. It can help strengthen the foundation of the GRA.
- GRAs have expressed interest to contribute to the three GOOS Decade programmes, however there is a lack of clarity on how to do that exactly.

GRASP Increase our interaction to improve current observation programs




Transfer of Technological and Scientific knowledge from Europe to Africa. This can be done through joint projects, summer schools and workshops, data sharing

IMOS Work with partners (e.g. CSIRO and BOM) to investigate how we can provide knowledge and capacity to our regional neighbors

Ocean Observing Co-Design


GRASP Take advantage of new technologies to improve ocean observation
