The logo Graphic Consists of four inseparable elements:

- **1. Green check mark**, indicates there are indicators of IOC UNESCO Tsunami Ready that need to be completed.
- 2. The three tsunami waves indicating this logo is for tsunami hazards
- **3. Pictures of people** depicting that IOC-UNESCO Tsunami Ready is based on community preparedness
- 4. The blue circles (or the square) describe that IOC-UNESCO Tsunami Ready program is a global program covering the Indian Ocean, the Pacific Ocean, the North East Atlantic Ocean and the Mediterranean and Caribbean Seas.
- 5. The title in white font reading "Tsunami Ready" enclosed in a blue-background box.
- 6. The year indicate the period of recognition


