


- Bring together Fiji government stakeholders, including Community and Non-government Organizations, to inform on the Fiji Tsunami Ready Programme

# Why Tsunami Ready?





Most tsunamis are local (< 1 hr) or regional (1-3 hrs)</li>
 In the Pacific, 99% of deaths from local or regional tsunamis (Global, 90% of deaths)
