Subject: Short-term secondment of international staff from NTWCs

of WG-SCS Member States to the SCSTAC

The South China Sea Tsunami Advisory Center (SCSTAC) began full operation on 5 November 2019 and the "User's Guide for the South China Sea Tsunami Advisory Center (SCSTAC) products for the South China Sea Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System" was published as IOC Technical Series, 149 in September 2019.

At its 10th meeting, the Regional Working Group on Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System for the South China Sea Region (WG-SCS) welcomed SCSTAC's proposal to continue with the International Secondment Programme by hosting 2 and 3 experts from SCS-WG Member States in 2022 for a two-month period with fruitful and satisfactory outcomes: Ms Gail Rivera (PHIVOLCS, Philippines), Mr Gatut Daniarsyad (BMKG, Indonesia), and Mr Mohd Nashriq Abd Rahman (MMD, Malaysia), Mr Nguyen Thanh Hai (IG, Viet Nam) and Mr Dandy Navarro Camero (PHIVOLCS, Philippines).

In this context, we are pleased to invite WG-SCS Member State to nominate one candidate to work at SCSTAC as an international staff from 18 September to 17 November 2023. The date could be slightly adjusted according to the availability of candidates.

- receive training on the earthquake location and focal mechanism inversion and tsunami scenario database, forecast model and decision support system of the SCSTAC;
- serve as a watch-stander once every week with a shift time of 12 hours; and
- conduct communication and coordination among WG-SCS Member States regarding the activities related to the full operation of SCSTAC.

The international staff will be hosted by the SCSTAC at the National Marine Environmental Forecasting Center (NMEFC) of the Chinese Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR). Workspace and facilities, return international air tickets, accommodations, local transportations, and living allowances (5,000-10,000 RMB per month depending on the level of the candidate) will be provided by SCSTAC. The first month's living allowances will be paid on arrival, and the second month's living allowances will be paid one month later. Medical insurance and visa fees are at the expense of candidates. During the period of their secondment, the employers of staff on loan to SCSTAC will be required to pay their salaries as usual.

The selection criteria of candidates who will receive funding from SCSTAC are as follows:

- The candidate must be a formal duty staff at a National Tsunami Warning Center with experience in seismic monitoring, processing and tsunami modelling tools. The candidate should be able to conduct tsunami warning and emergency response operations independently;
- The candidate should preferably be aged between 25 and 45 and have degree or license in seismology, oceanography or related subjects;
- The application form must be signed by the applicant's Tsunami National Contact (TNC) or the Tsunami Warning Focal Point (TWFP).

The attached form duly completed by the nominee, along with a CV and a medical report, should be sent by email to Bernardo Aliaga (b.aliaga@unesco.org), ICG/PTWS Technical Secretary, with copy to Dr WANG Dakui (dakui.nmefc@gmail.com) and Dr XU Zhiguo (xuzg@nmefc.cn) at NMEFC/MNR, by 14 July 2023. The successful candidates will be notified by 28 July 2023.
