

ENHANCING REGIONAL COOPERATION: Foster collaboration and cooperation among member states, regional organizations, and stakeholders to address common challenges related to the marine environment and promote sustainable development in the Caribbean and adjacent regions.

CAPACITY BUILDING AND KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE: Strengthen the capacity of IOCARIBE member states in various areas, including promoting knowledge exchange and sharing best practices among member states.

DATA SHARING AND INFORMATION MANAGEMENT: Promote the sharing of data, information, and knowledge among IOCARIBE member states and stakeholders, establishing and strengthening national data centers, adopting FAIR and CARE principles.

AWARENESS AND VISIBILITY: Raise awareness and increase the visibility of IOCARIBE among stakeholders, decision-makers, and the wider public. This includes leveraging existing regional and international efforts to promote the impacts and benefits of IOCARIBE initiatives.

YOUTH AND STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT: Actively engage youth and stakeholders, including local communities, NGOs, and the private sector, in IOCARIBE programs and initiatives.
