4.11. TSUNAMI GENERATED BY VOLCANOES (CONTINUATION)

4.11.2. MONITORING AND WARNING SYSTEM AGAINST A TSUNAMI GENERATED BY VOLCANOES IN THE PACIFIC

Chairperson Mr Nishimae will draw attention and express appreciation for the work of the TOWS-WG Ad hoc Task Team on Tsunamis Generated by Volcanoes under the Task Team on

Tsunami Watch Operations (TT TWO) which delivered its Report at the TOWS-XVI session. The report is the culmination of that work and provides an overview of how volcanos can generate tsunamis, modelling techniques specific to volcanic tsunamis, requirements and examples of monitoring and warning systems, and finally recommendations for the future.

The review of the report by the TOWS-WG and subsequently its endorsement by the Thirty-second Session of the IOC Assembly (21–30 June 2023), resulted in the following decisions:

<u>Decides</u> that warning systems for tsunamis generated by volcanoes should be considered and coordinated as part of the UNESCO/IOC Global tsunami and other Ocean-related Hazards Warning and Mitigation System (GOHWMS), and also when possible be part of a MHEWS;

<u>Instructs</u> the regional Intergovernmental Coordination Groups (ICGs) to:

(iv) Consider and implement the recommendations of the Ad Hoc Team on Tsunamis Generated by Volcanoes with respect to the hazard assessment, monitoring and warning requirements, including costs of deploying and maintaining such systems. Where identified tsunamis generated by volcanoes may impact multiple Member States, TSPs for the relevant ocean basin tsunami warning and mitigation systems should consider if they need to be involved in monitoring and provision of threat advice;

Requests the IOC Secretariat:

- (vi) help inform Member States widely on the potential tsunami hazard from volcanoes by distributing the Tsunamis Generated by Volcanoes Report, including the List of Tsunamigenic Volcanoes, to:
- Volcano Observatories;
- UNESCO/IOC Member States.

He will then invite Dr François Schindelé (France), Chair of the now former *Task Team on Tsunamis Generated by Volcanoes* to provide an introduction on this agenda item.

He will then ask Member States to provide their views on the decisions and instructions of the IOC Assembly. After closing interventions, he will break for intra-session working groups.
