Background:

Adopted in December 2015 by the United Nations General Assembly, World Tsunami Awareness Day (WTAD) is set to take place on 5 November. The day aligns with the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015–2030 ("the Sendai Framework"), which is the international agreement to prevent and reduce disaster losses. The purpose of WTAD is to raise awareness about reducing tsunami-related risks and enhance community preparedness.

The theme of 2023 WTAD mirror the theme of the International Day of Disaster Reduction: fighting inequality for a resilient future, focusing on raising awareness about the underlying disaster risk drivers – poverty, inequality, and vulnerability – that make tsunamis more deadly for those most at risk as well as how the aftermath of a tsunami can drive vulnerable people further into poverty and exacerbate inequality.
