





Communities of Practice are voluntary groups of endorsed Decade Actions that work on similar themes or in similar geographies. They allow Decade Actions to connect, collaborate, and exchange ideas to collectively fulfil the objectives of the Ocean Decade. Communities of Practice can be either **thematic** (based around the Ocean Decade Challenges) or **geographic** (based around major ocean basins).

# How can I join an existing Community of Practice?

Communities of Practice can be found on the **Ocean Decade Network** (forum.oceandecade.org). Each endorsed programme, project, and contribution selects related Communities of Practice when they are completing their Decade Action profile. Once endorsed, their team members may join those Communities of Practice. Decade Actions can join as many Communities of Practice that they feel they can contribute to. Decade *activities* are not included in this opportunity.

- Become an **endorsed Decade Action** (click "Take Action!" on the Ocean Decade Network to find out more)
- Fill in your **Decade Action page**, including related Communities of Practice
- Team members represent your Decade Action on the Ocean Decade Network
- Ask your team members to **"request to join"** one or more of your Decade Action's related Communities of Practice







What is the function of the Decade Coordination Unit and Decade Collaborative Centres & Offices (DCCs & DCOs) in a Community of Practice?

**DCCs and DCOs have dedicated resources to act as facilitators and moderators** (**Group Admins**) **of Communities of Practice.** As part of this role, they are asked to attend regular Group Admin meetings and give annual activity reports. In case there is no DCC or DCO to facilitate a Community of Practice, volunteer Decade Actions will act as Group Admins.
