Police protection and security arrangements shall be up to United Nations Security Management System (UNSMS) standards. As such, the Designated Official (DO) for Indonesia is the authority responsible for the security of United Nations personnel, premises and assets throughout the country and must be kept informed of the measures envisaged. The police and security arrangements will be under the direct supervision and/or control of a senior officer designated by the Government who will work in close coordination with the security coordinator appointed for this purpose by UNESCO and/or the locally competent United Nations security Officer. To this end, Mr. Nicolas Hergot, UNESCO Head of Security, has been designated as the UNESCO security coordinator, and Mr Hasim Tarloolu, UNOSSG Deputy Security Adviser. For its part, the Government has designated: Mr. ... Management of ... (Mobile: +62 ... ) as Head of Security Officer (SO)."
