

## UNESCO-IOC 14<sup>th</sup> Session of the Intergovernmental Coordination Group for the Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (ICG/IOTWMS-XIV)

## Jakarta, Indonesia

16-19 November 2024

# **INFORMATION NOTE**

### 1. Background

In 2005, the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) Assembly at its 23rd Session decided, by Resolution XXIII-12, to create the Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (IOTWMS) to be governed by an Intergovernmental Coordination Group (ICG/IOTWMS).

At its 13th Session, held in Bali, Indonesia during 28 November to 1 December 2022, the ICG/IOTWMS decided to organise the 14th Session in Indonesia back-to-back with the <u>2nd UNESCO-IOC Global Tsunami Symposium</u>.

The 14th session of the ICG/IOTWMS is being organised by the UNESCO-IOC Secretariat for the ICG/IOTWMS and hosted by the Republic of Indonesia through its Agency for Meteorology Climatology and Geophysics (BMKG) at the Sheraton Jakarta Soekarna Hatta Airport Hotel in Jakarta. The Session will review progress of the IOTWMS workplan and decide on recommendations to enhance tsunami warning and preparedness in the Indian Ocean region. It will be conducted in hybrid mode.

### 2. Invitations

All eligible (in-person) participants will receive an official invitation letter from the UNESCO-IOC ICG/IOTWMS Secretariat and from BMKG. The invitation letters may be needed for your visa arrangement. Should you require additional information for your visa please contact the organizers listed in Section 13 below.

## 3. Organisation of the Meeting and Venue

The 14<sup>th</sup> Session will be organized as an hybrid meeting each day from 02:00 to 12:00 UTC (09:00 to 17:00 local time), allowing both in-person and online participation across the Indian Ocean. - III. Visa exemption or visa on arrival for leisure purpose

## 7. Health Protocol

SATUSEHAT Health Pass (SSHP) for Entry to Republic of Indonesia. All passengers traveling from abroad are required to fill in a Health Pass prior to entry into Indonesia.

Please complete the SSHP form before boarding your flight at https://sshp.kemkes.go.id/.

For all participant to help maintain a healthy environment, we encourage you to practice good hygiene by washing your hands regularly and using hand sanitizers provided. We also recommend bringing any personal medications you may need during your stay. If you feel unwell, please contact our staff for assistance. Your cooperation helps us ensure a safe and pleasant atmosphere for everyone. No vaccination records are required to enter Indonesia.

### 8. Time

The time in Jakarta, Indonesia is 7 hours ahead of UTC.

### 9. Weather


Jakarta has a tropical monsoon climate. In November the average daily temperature range is  $23^{\circ}$ C (night) –  $31^{\circ}$ C (day). It will be the wet season, so expect rain showers. The average monthly rainfall for November is 100 mm.

## **10. Currency**

The currency used in Indonesia is the Indonesian Rupiah (IDR). One US dollar is approximately 15.850 Indonesian Rupiah (IDR, UN exchange rate for October 2024). You can find a money changer in the Airport as soon as you clear the immigration. There are also money changers in the city, hotels, malls and banks. Most shops accept credit card (Visa). Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) are also available in malls and banks; please note that the ATM only accepts cards with a Visa or Cirrus Logo.

## **11. Electricity**

The standard voltage throughout Indonesia is normally 230 Volt and with a standard frequency of 50 Hz. Most power plugs and sockets in Indonesia are type C and F, as below. If you're coming from a country that does not use this type of sockets, you should bring an adapter.



## 12. Places of Interest:

Sheraton Bandara Jakarta is located near Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, which makes it convenient for travelers with short stays. While the immediate area is more focused on business and logistics, there are some interesting places nearby that visitors can explore:

## - Pantai Indah Kapuk (PIK)

Distance: Around 30-40 minutes by car

What to do: This trendy area in North Jakarta offers a wide range of restaurants, cafés, and outdoor activities. You can explore PIK Avenue Mall, enjoy food at the vibrant culinary hubs, or take a stroll at the Mangrove Forest. The beachfront, Waterbom PIK (a waterpark), and golf courses also make it an appealing place for leisure activities.

## - Ancol Dreamland

Distance: Around 45 minutes by car

What to do: Ancol Dreamland is Jakarta's largest recreational park. It features attractions such as Dunia Fantasi (Fantasy World amusement park), SeaWorld Ancol, and Ancol Beach. There are also golf courses, resorts, and numerous places to dine, making it perfect for family outings or those looking to enjoy coastal activities.

## - Taman Mini Indonesia Indah (TMII)

Distance: Around 1 hour by car

What to do: Taman Mini Indonesia Indah is a cultural theme park showcasing the diversity of Indonesian culture. You can explore pavilions representing the country's various provinces, complete with traditional houses, handicrafts, and performances. The park also has museums, gardens, and a sky-lift to view the entire area.

### - Old Town (Kota Tua Jakarta)

Distance: Around 50 minutes by car

What to do: Jakarta's Old Town is rich in history and colonial architecture. You can visit the Fatahillah Square, which houses the Jakarta History Museum, the Wayang (Puppet) Museum, and the Fine Art and Ceramics Museum. The area has a charming atmosphere with cafés and local street food, making it a great place to take in Jakarta's cultural heritage.

#### - TangCity Mall

Distance: Around 25 minutes by car

What to do: Located in nearby Tangerang, this is a large shopping mall offering retail stores, dining options, and entertainment like cinemas. It is a convenient spot for shopping or grabbing a bite to eat.

### - AEON Mall BSD City

Distance: Around 45 minutes by car

What to do: AEON Mall BSD City is one of the most popular shopping malls in the area, particularly known for its Japanese-themed stores and food options. It has a wide range of international brands, a large food court, and entertainment like ice skating and cinemas.

#### - Golf Courses

Cengkareng Golf Club (5 minutes from Sheraton Bandara): A popular 18-hole course for golf enthusiasts.

Damai Indah Golf (Pantai Indah Kapuk): Another well-regarded golf course around 40 minutes away.

## - Soewarna Business Park

Distance: Very close (within 5-10 minutes)

What to do: If you are on a business trip, this business park near the airport offers offices, shops, and some dining options. It is convenient for those with work-related activities.

# - Alam Sutera

Distance: 20-30 minutes by car

What to do: Tangerang has an interesting local scene, with traditional markets, local food, and nearby areas such as BSD City, where you can visit museums or modern shopping centres like Summarecon Mall.
