#### **Tsunami Ready Evaluation Survey**

- Pilot Tsunami Ready Evaluation Survey updated with CARIBE EWS TT Tsunami Ready, CTIC, ITIC-CAR, UNESCO-IOC Technical Secretary
- Pilot survey conducted March to June 2024 by ITIC-CAR intern to assess the experience of recognized to collect feedback to identify the strengths and weaknesses of the program and improve the recognition process
- Analysis finalized August 2024to provide recommendations for adjustments to enhance the program and its assessment framework:
- o translation of Tsunami Ready evaluation form into French and Spanish
- establishment and implementation of an annual reporting mechanism based on post-recognition surveys to monitor program progress and measure its effectiveness
- designation of national Tsunami Ready focal points and adequate training to ensure consistent implementation across different countries
- o ensure that the CTIC remains the centralized database for storing survey data.
- technical support of a qualified social scientist required to analyze the collected data and provide relevant recommendations
- o feasibility of organizing a Tsunami Ready Summit, also a ICG/CARIB EWS XVII Recommendation
