Intergovernmental

- 1. Develop Minimum Competency Training Course (MCTC) based on the competency frameworkstor National Tsunami Warning Centers personnel, including addressing NTWC local response SOP and best practice.
- 2. Vanuatu, Solomon Islands, Nauru, Fiji, Samoa, and Tonga to pilot MCTC as well as report progress and lessons learnt to ICG/PTWS WG1, 2, and 3.
- 3. Coordinate and support on-going training and sharing of best practices on the Implementation of UNESCO/IOC Tsunami Ready Recognition Programme & similar programmes.
- 4. Review the existing PTWS guideline for National Tsunami Warning Centers in responding to local Tsunami to ensure consideration of non-seismic and complex sources for warning operations.
- 5. Develop a Tsunami preparedness capacity assessment to address PICT warning and mitigation capabilities (Member countries and IOC).
