# Feedback from INFCOM MG Meeting

- Ongoing GOOS Reform Process welcomed by INFCOM leadership.
- Reform to be tabled at upcoming EC Meeting
- Strong commitment from INFCOM president to maintain engagement in ocean observations, and strengthen alignment between WMO and ocean community
- Ocean domain recognised as strategic priority
- Emphasis on alignment with global frameworks and long-term sustainability of ocean observations
- Increased focus on data integration, system performance monitoring, and operationalisation.

# Priority Actions for Ocean Domain

- Implementation of GBON for oceans (focus on operational delivery and compliance, strong link to SOFF funding opportunities in the long-term)
- WIS2.0 transition (critical for improved data sharing and interoperability)
- Update of WMO-No.8 (inclusion of ocean volume observations)
- Clear alignment of roles between WMO, IOC, and the Ocean Forecasting Community (e.g ETOOFS Guide)

## Quick Wins

- WDQMS tools for ocean monitoring
- GBON performance monitoring
- Promotion of SoG of the Global Ocean
- WIS2.0 pilot nodes
- Ocean engagements (TECO-observation conference)



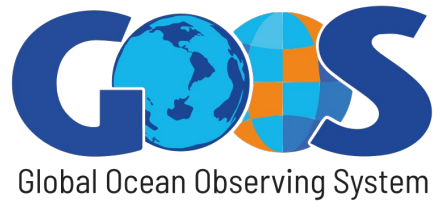
# Joint WMO-IOC Collaborative Board (JCB)

*Established in 2019 with WMO governance reform as a high level strategic advisory body to continue the activities with common interest to WMO and IOC.*

- JCB survey confirmed the member priorities (GBON, Data, coastal resilience, CD)
- Progress of subgroups and other activities
  - Observations – Propose two new variables (Sub surface temp, Sea level)for GBON expansion
  - Data – ToR under review to reflect survey results
  - Mapping of coupled modelling activities of the two organizations
- Report back to Executive Councils
  - Member survey results
  - Propose to operate under the strategic plans of the two organizations and not to have a separate JCB strategy
  - Update JCB ToR to reflect the decision on the strategic plan
